Members may now sign in at the meeting place. **Pre-registration is not required except for those activities listed in BOLD in the Schedule Summary below and also noted in each activity listing.** Pre-registration is to ensure we adhere to DEC group size limits for state and high peak areas. All hikes will start at the time and location specified in each individual hike description. Leaders and co-leaders will have phone numbers listed so that they may answer any questions participants may have about possible last-minute hike changes. Please try to arrive at the starting location 15 minutes before the start time so that you can be signed in and receive instructions. **Reminder: If you plan to meet at the trailhead, call the leader to verify scheduled activity for late modifications.**

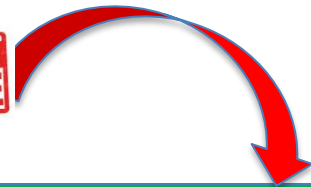
