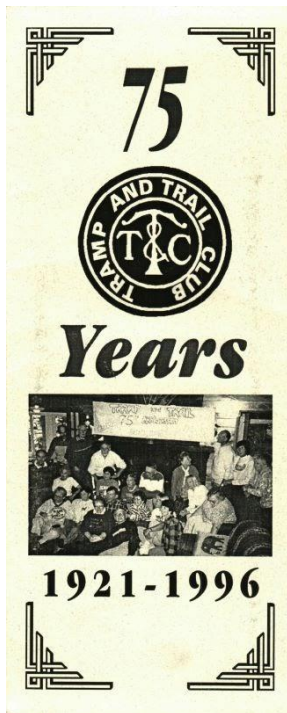


## History Corner
