Please try to arrive at the starting location 15 minutes before the start time so that you can be signed in and receive instructions. **Reminder: If you plan to meet at the trailhead, call the leader to verify scheduled activity for late modifications.**

Per DEC regulations, all outings on state land are limited in group size. High Peaks areas of the Adirondacks and Catskills are limited to 15 per group. All other state lands are limited to 20 per group. Pre-registration is required so we can make arrangements to accommodate all who want to hike.
